MINUTES OF MEETING

MINUTES OF RCG MEETING HELD ON 14TH OF SEPTEMBER 2022 AT GOLF VIEW HOTEL, IKEJA

Rotarian Bridget Okocha was called to stand in for the Secretary who was unavoidably absent.

Attendance: As contained in the Club's attendance register.

The meeting fellowship started 6.30pm and the meeting was called to Order by the President at exactly 7.05 pm

Rotary grace was taken by Rotarian Erica Chikwendu

Object of Rotary was taken by PAG Muyiwa Matuluko.

The 4-way test was taken by Rotarian Tosin Olawoyin

President's welcome address:

The president welcomed everyone present, both physical and online to the eleventh week meeting, thanking God for Devine protection.

He welcomed those that attended the 4th All African Rotary Institute, Zone 22 at Abidjan and lived to everyone, particularly the new Rotarians the values of attending Rotary trainings and seminars. He added that Rotary institute attendance is open to all Rotarians. He recalled that last week, it was mentioned that the board held a meeting where it was resolved that there should be a membership audit of the club members. The president stated that the Chaiman of the Membership Retention Committee would come up with a criteria to be used for that.

The President mentioned that the board had an emergency last week and five persons were interviewed and that their profiles are already up on the Club's platforms for members to comment. After the statutory 7 days without objections from members, the Membership chair will advise them on payments and advice the house the likely date of induction.

Some members agreed that there is a genuine need for the membership audit as there is no need carrying large number of members but only a few of us are participating.

The President told of the good news of the Global Grant aided Eye Hospital Project payment by RI which he said he has constituted an implementation committee and giving them terms of reference. Also, the District Grant (WASH) Programme is also set for commencement from the District but, the President reported that his visit to the primary school where we were to carry out the WASH project showed that a politician has come over night to fix borehole for the school, thereby rendering school not to be perfectly qualified for WASH project. However, the President see this as a good omen, as Rotary's spread of humanitarian services have woken politicians up on their duties. It was therefore suggested by members that RCG should not only consider schools, that our attention should also be directed towards the Police as their facilities are also in shambles. However, PDG Niji Raji explained that this particular District Grant was targeted at primary schools. Friday, 16th September, is our Tree Planting day, the President announced.

He enjoyed all club members to find time to attend. Thursday is the hands-on Exercrise at the school premises, African Church Primary School, College Road, Ifako-Ijaiye. to prepare the spots to plant trees.

15th September is the Polio Seminar Day at the District Office. The Polio Chair, Rtn Bridget Okocha, was on hand to explain what to expect as she extended invitation to all members that wish to attend. The Doyen and other elders of the club raised issues of non remittance of payments of members to the District and encouraged the President to quickly abd immediately do the needful.

For the Basic Education and Literacy Month, the chair of Youth Service, Rtn. Erica Chikwendu, was on hand to speak on the arrangements to train some food vendors at Lanre Awolokun Senior Secondary School on food handling and simple book keeping. To cover 19th to 23rd September. According to her, a speaker to talk to them on vital issues is been sought. She asked members for donation of souvenirs, packaged items, utensils, aprons, etc, as gifts on the closing ceremony on Friday. The President Elect also spoke on the status of the Investiture planning coming up, 25th September.

She informed that the committee has stopped adverts to allow the printer enough time to deliver. PAG Kasim suggested thT the closing date for collection of adverts should be this weekend. The PE pointed out that it was 11 days away and reminded members to come early for the Club's group photograph which will be 12.30 noon.


